- 28 organisations are licensed to access driver data through the DVLA's automated ADD channel
- DVLA process 3.2 million driving licence checks a year on behalf of organisations that take road safety seriously
- ADLV represents this market of leading providers who care about the quality of the driving licence checking market
- Our members account for 80% of the 3.2 million checks processed each year
